## Tasting Notes:

Very dark purple color, with soaring aromatics of black plum, exotic Asian spice box and ripe blackberries. Lush in the mouth with fine texture the fruit is nicely balanced by the acidity. Boysenberry and black currant flavors are flanked by well-polished tannins and a subtle, dark exuberance of ripe fruits that carry all the way through to the long, complex finish.
